Volunteer attorneys will help low-income immigrants with Legal Permanent Resident status obtain citizenship through the Naturalization process in a series of clinics.

THE FIRST CLINIC WILL BE HELD IN ISLANDIA ON OCTOBER 30, 2018.

The program will provide:

Free assistance from an attorney in completing the USCIS Naturalization application and Fee Waiver forms.

Spanish interpreters for any non-English speaking clients.

Applicants MUST call ahead to be screened for eligibility for this program.
